

BIG BUTTERFLY MONTH SEPTEMBER 2025

SUPER SAPIENS; THE ZOOLOGICAL SOCIETY OF GOVT. COLLEGE SOLAN (HP)

The Department of Zoology celebrated the spirit of learning, creativity, and environmental awareness through a month long event "Big Butterfly Month" which beautifully combined fieldwork, academic learning, and cultural expression. Various activities held during the month are listed below.

1. Documentary Screening

Documentary entitled 'Butterflies; The Children of Sun' was shown to the students to orient them towards the diversity, habitat, habits, morphology and Physiology and behaviour.

2. Field visits and observations:-

As part of butterfly month activities, students from bachelor of science 3rd year and 2nd year actively participated in field visit organised on 13 September, 2025 and 28 September, 2025. To ensure better coordination and broader exploration, the students were divided into four groups, each assigned to a different visiting site. During these visits, students observed and documented various species of butterflies, studied their natural habitats, flight patterns, an ecological importance. The experience provided them with valuable practical exposure and a deeper understanding of biodiversity and environmental balance.

3. 4th October event:- Sharing the Knowledge And Spreading Awareness Day

The awareness event began with a warm welcome of guests (Dr.Manju Thakur , Dr.ArtaNegi , Dr.YogeshJain, Dr. Ramesh Kumar, Dr. P.P Negi)

Students then shared their learning through various presentations and reports.

Presentations :- unique Butterflies by Suman Singh (B.Sc. 2nd year) , interesting facts about butterflies by Shrishti (B.Sc. 2nd year) focussing on butterfly diversity, colour, patterns and life cycles. Reports by Aryan (Leader

1) and Poonam Chauhan (Leader 2) ,Yashaswi(Leader 3) , Neha (Leader 4) presenting highlights from the field observation . The event concluded with an interactive quiz conducted by Megha, adding excitement and engagement among the students. At the end of the session, Dr.Manju Thakur and Dr. Arti Negi delivered informative and motivational speeches related to butterflies and environmental conservation. Their words inspired students to stay curious, continue exploring nature , and understand the role of every living being in maintaining ecological harmony.

4. Concluding Event of Big Butterfly Month

The grand finale of the butterfly month celebration took place on 6th October, turning the college hall into a hub of colours, music and excitement. 



सोलन कॉलेज में 'बटरफ्लाई मंथ' संपन्न, शोध के साथ कविता-कहानी से भी मोहा मन
