




## **Educational trip to DMR on 10<sup>th</sup> September 2024**

On 10.09.2024, a group of 40 students of B.Sc 3<sup>rd</sup> year (Botany) visited DMR Chambaghat on the occasion of 27<sup>th</sup> Mushroom Mela, 2024 under the guidance of Dr. Prem Prakesh Negi and Mrs. Aarti Negi, (Assistant Professors of Botany department). It was an exposure/educational trip to DMR to gather knowledge about the mushroom cultivation technology. DMR was established in 1983 at Chambaghat Solan HP. Solan has been designated as the Mushroom City of India on 10<sup>th</sup> Sept. 1997. Since then DMR celebrates this day as mushroom mela. Mushroom growers from all India gathered here and progressive growers were rewarded on this day. Students visited stalls of different NGOs, private companies, farmers and gathered information about edible, medicinal, seasonal mushroom such as *Agaricus*, *Cordyceps*, *Enoki*, *Shiitake*, *Ganoderma*, etc. Students also visited different stalls of companies involved in the technical installment in mushroom production units. They saw different value added products made up of mushrooms. There was a seminar for the farmers and students which was inaugurated by the Governor of H.P. Shri Shiv Pratap Shukla, the chief guest of the event. Director of DMR, Dr. V.P Sharma gave a detailed presentation on Mushroom Cultivation technology. Dr. Rajeshwar Singh Chandel, Vice Chancellor of Dr. Yashwant Singh Parmar University of Horticulture and Forestry Nauni, Solan, also gave information about Mushroom cultivation. Students were enriched with the knowledge of different varieties of mushrooms and their cultivation practices. They were also motivated enough to practice mushroom cultivation as self-employment and entrepreneurship.
