

Report on the Programme "A Day Celebrating the Legacy of Alfred Nobel"

The Chemistry Club *Lavoisier* of the Department of Chemistry, Government College Solan, organized a special one-day event on **September 16, 2025**, on the theme "A Day Celebrating the Legacy of Alfred Nobel." The program aimed to honor the contributions of Nobel laureates in Chemistry and to inspire students by highlighting the transformative impact of scientific discoveries. As part of the celebration, a **poster-making competition** was held in which **33 posters** depicting Nobel Prize winners in Chemistry from 1901 to 2024 and their contributions were presented. The competition witnessed enthusiastic participation, with nearly **150 students** showcasing the life, research, and achievements of eminent scientists. The event began with a warm welcome by students Rishita and Vanshika.

The winners of the competition were:

- **First Prize:** Aditi and Yashika (B.Sc. I Year)
- **Second Prize:** Rishita and Prachi (B.Sc. III Year)
- **Third Prize:** Nitika and Srishti (B.Sc. III Year)

A highlight of the event was the invited lecture by **Prof. Chandra Prakash Bhasin**, former professor at Hemchandracharya North Gujarat University, Patan (Gujarat). Speaking on "The Legacy of Alfred Nobel," he provided a comprehensive overview of the background of the Nobel Prize, its founder Alfred Nobel, and the path-breaking contributions of Nobel laureates in Chemistry. His lecture shed light on the spirit of innovation and the role of scientific advancements in shaping society.

Addressing the gathering, **Dr. Maneesha Kohli, Principal of Government College Solan**, commended the students for their active participation and lauded the efforts of Chemistry Club *Lavoisier* in organizing such a meaningful academic event. सोलन कॉलेज में रसायन के नोबेल विजेताओं को किया याद

सोलन: राजकीय महाविद्यालय सोलन के रसायन विज्ञान विभाग के 'केमिस्ट्री क्लब लैवोयियर' ने मंगलवार के दिन (ए डे सेलिब्रेटिंग द लिगेसी ऑफ अल्फ्रेड नोबेल) विषय पर एक विशेष कार्यक्रम का आयोजन किया। इस कार्यक्रम का मुख्य उद्देश्य छात्रों को रसायन विज्ञान के क्षेत्र में नोबेल पुरस्कार विजेताओं के ऐतिहासिक योगदान से परिचित कराना था।

कार्यक्रम के तहत एक पोस्टर प्रतियोगिता आयोजित की गई, जिसमें लगभग 150 विद्यार्थियों ने हिस्सा लिया। छात्रों ने 1901 से 2024 तक के रसायन विज्ञान के नोबेल पुरस्कार विजेताओं और उनकी खोजों पर आधारित 33 शानदार पोस्टर प्रदर्शित किए। प्रतियोगिता में बीएससी प्रथम वर्ष की अदिति एवं याशिका ने प्रथम, तृतीय वर्ष की रीषिता एवं प्राची ने द्वितीय, तथा तृतीय वर्ष की ही नितिका एवं सृष्टि ने तृतीय स्थान प्राप्त किया।
