


4.4 Green and clean campus

i) Green initiatives of institution (atleast 3)

1. Energy conservation: The institution promotes energy conservation and the use of alternate energy sources by installing solar panels on the campus. In addition, energy-efficient measures such as LED bulbs and tube lights have been implemented to reduce electricity consumption and encourage sustainable practices.
2. Solid waste in the college is managed through regular collection supervised by block in-charges and executed by sweepers on each floor. Waste is then segregated at the source into green, blue, and red bins for efficient recycling and eco-friendly disposal.
3. The college conducts Green Audits to review its environmental practices and strengthen an eco-friendly campus atmosphere. In line with sustainable development, Government College Solan works to increase green cover, conserve energy, and adopt eco-friendly measures such as solar lighting and rainwater harvesting. The audit aims to ensure environmental sustainability by documenting campus biodiversity, promoting a clean and safe environment, reducing energy use, and recommending ways to improve overall greenery and biodiversity
4. Rainwater harvesting: A proper rainwater harvesting tank is made in the college and the water collected is utilized for various purposes.
5. Eco-Club has been constituted in the college to Spread awareness about importance of green and clean environment
