

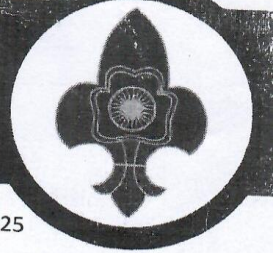

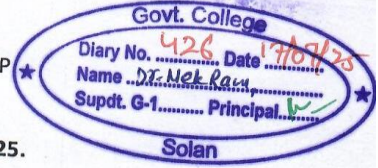

- Rally and Alumni Engagement


You are requested to ensure maximum participation of active and former Scouts/Guides, Rovers/Rangers, Unit Leaders and other members in this celebration.

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

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Report: Celebration of World Scout Scarf Day by Rover/ Ranger unit of GC Solan
